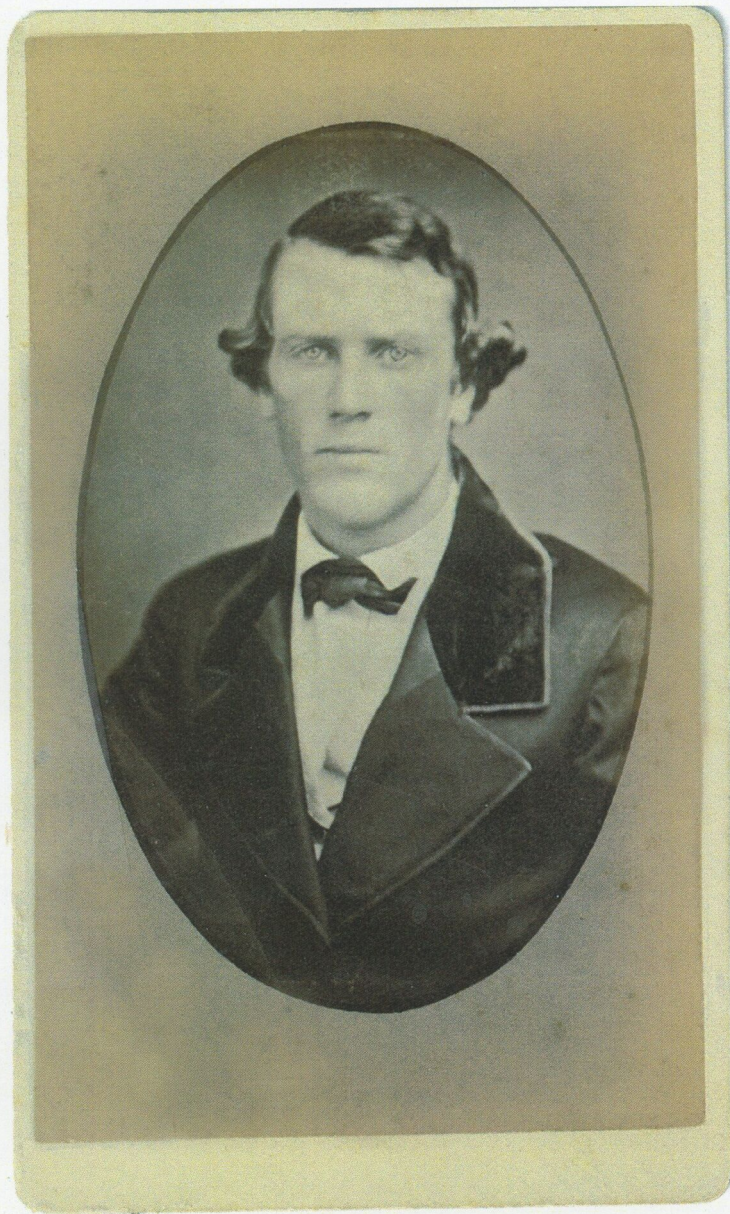

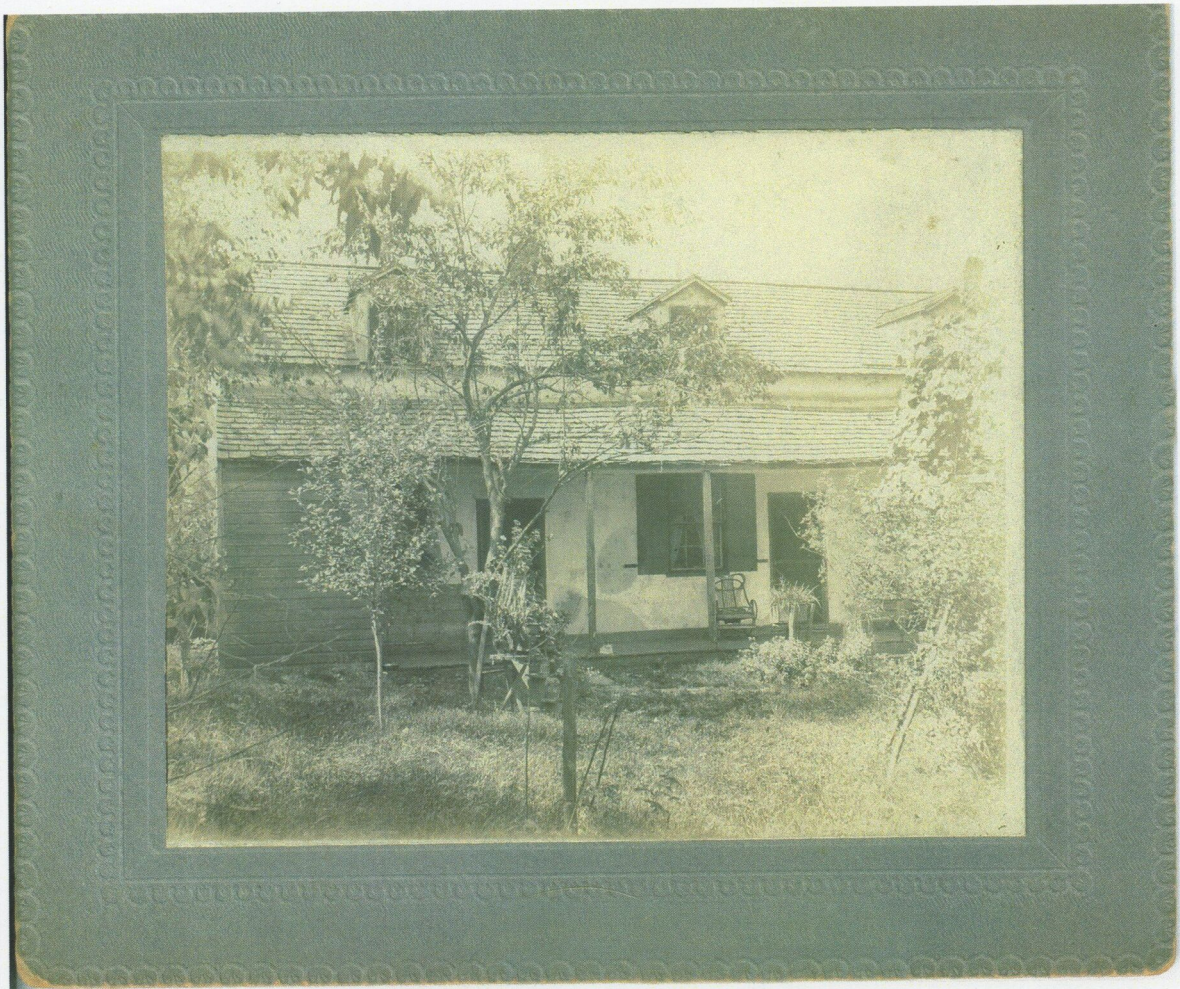

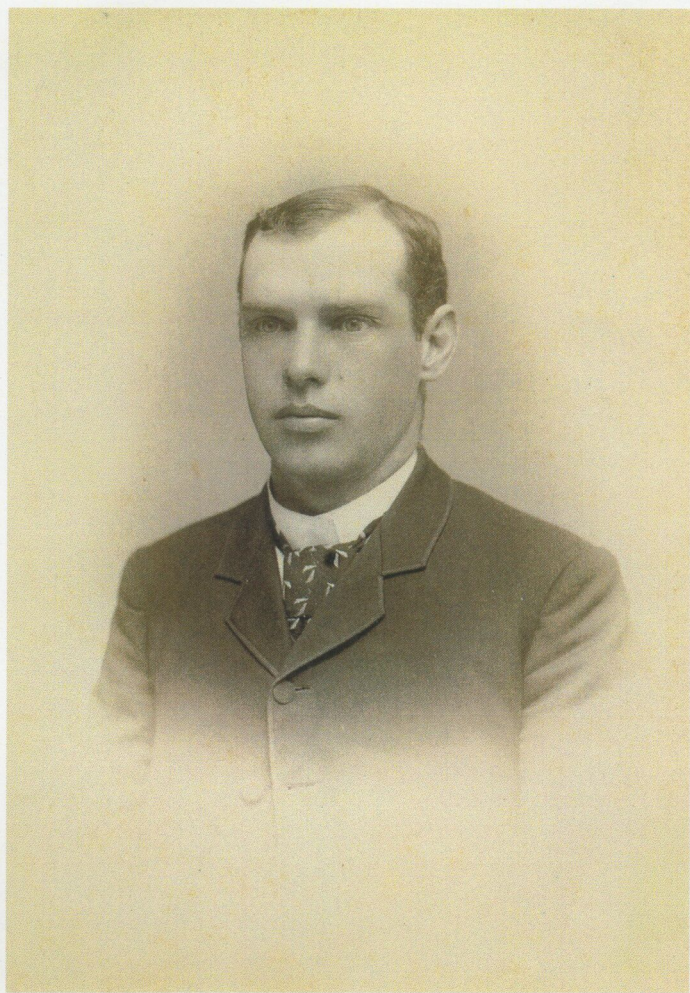

## *Samuel E. Grove (1856-1920)*

*Samuel E. Grove, a well known school teacher, died at the Washington County Hospital, Saturday night at 10:30 o'clock, of complications, in his 63rd year. he was formerly from Wolfsville, this county, but has been living in Hagerstown for the past seven years. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church, Odd Fellows and Knights of Pythias. Besides His Wife, Louise Bertina (Lewis) Grove (1858-1944) Mr. Grove is survived by four daughters: Albertina, Irene, Ruth and Babie; three sisters: Mrs. Annie Reid, Myersville; Mrs. Mollie Powell, near Hagerstown; Mrs. Ida Ludy, Downsville Pike. Two brothers, Charles, Boonsboro, and Denton, California, also survive. Funeral was held today. Interment in the cemetery adjoining Lutheran church at Wolfsville.*

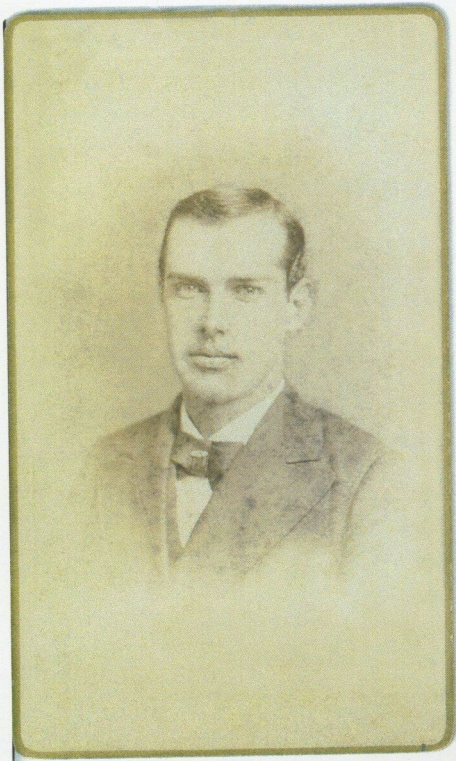
